THE STORY

Kev'Laa is an independent UK electronic artist, DJ, songwriter and visual creator from North West England. A lifelong clubber shaped by the late-1990s and 2000s UK dance scene, he spent years making music as a serious creative hobby before moving into a more focused public phase.

His catalogue is concept-led rather than genre-locked, moving through progressive house, melodic techno, trance, deep house, tech-house, breaks, acid, ambient and piano-led work. Tracks often begin with a character, image, joke, memory or emotional question, then expand into artwork, short-form film and alternate versions. That approach also drives multilingual remakes and the growing Kev'Laa Universe.

Before focusing more publicly on music, Kev'Laa worked across financial services, strategy design, behavioural science and AI innovation. That unusual background now informs a structured but playful practice. AI-assisted software is one part of the toolset; the writing, concepts, direction, selection, editing and final decisions remain human-led. Independently, he also manages release delivery, catalogue records, rights registrations, visual content and promotion.



WHAT CONNECTS THE CATALOGUE

Emotion without solemnity.
Club energy without one fixed genre.
Visual worlds that start with the idea, not as an afterthought.
A process that stays curious, structured and self-aware.

HUMAN-LED, TOOL-ASSISTED

AI-assisted software is part of the production and visual toolkit. Kev'Laa remains responsible for concepts, writing, direction, selection, editing and final creative decisions.
